Montgomery County Chapter Supports The LUNAR LION TEAM

Penn State has joined the Google Lunar X Prize competition to land a privately funded space craft on the moon by 2015. The launch and execution of Penn State's craft-the Lunar Lion-will be the culmination of a multiyear, interdisciplinary effort to meet the requirements of the competition and vie for its top rewards....\$20,000,000. A commercial launch vehicle will carry the Lunar Lion into space and place it on a trajectory to the moon. After 5 days of space travel, the Lunar Lion will execute a controlled descent to the lunar surface. During the mission the space craft will transmit high resolution

photographic images and video to "Mission Control" at Penn State. In this exciting mission, the Lunar Lion team, led by Michael Paul, aerospace engineer, will compete against 28 other teams to accomplish the first moon landing in more than 30 years. We are proud to say that Penn State is the only University competing in the race. WE ARE...landing the first University-built space craft on the moon.
